

Bus Drop Off and Pick Up

The bus drop off and pick up is located on Ganghofer Strasse which is on the South West end of the Oktoberfest grounds. Exit the grounds on the South West exit past the lady Bavaria statue. Follow Oda Schaefer Weg and proceed straight ahead, the road makes a slight bend to the right and turns into Ben Chorin Strasse until you reach Ganghofer Strasse.

Traveling by train to Oktoberfest

TO OKTOBERFEST: From the Garmisch Bahnhof take the train to Muenchen. You can purchase your ticket from one of the ticket machines in the station or through the DeutscheBahn App. Take the train until you reach the Muenchen Hauptbahnhof. From the Hauptbahnhof take the U-bahn (#4 or #5) to the Theresienwiese stop, this will be the first stop after leaving the Hauptbahnhof. You have arrived at the Oktoberfest.

TO GARMISCH: You will need to go to the Hauptbahnhof by either taking the U-bahn or walking. You can purchase your ticket from one of the ticket machines in the station or through the DeutscheBahn App. The U-bahn station is located on North West side of the Oktoberfest grounds. Take the U4 or U5 towards the Hauptbahnhof. You can also walk to the Hauptbahnhof by exiting the North side of the Oktoberfest grounds and head East on Bayerstrasse. The last train back to Garmisch is at 23:30. There will not be another train back to Garmisch until 04:50 the following morning.

I'm Lost

When you arrive at the Oktoberfest grounds it is always recommended to pick out a meeting point should you get separated from your party. TIP-the large Ferris wheel located on the South East side is one of the tallest structures on the grounds and seen easily from far away.

Tips for getting a seat in a tent

There are a total of 14 beer tents at Oktoberfest with a total seating capacity of 100,000. The majority of tables in the beer tents are reserved seating. Of the tables that are not reserved it is first come first serve. It is recommended that you try and get a table early if you want to sit in a tent. Often tables aren't reserved until 1600. You can sit at this table until then. There is open seating outside most of the tents; once again it is best to get there early as these tables fill up quickly especially if the weather is nice.

***On Saturday mornings admission to the beer tents is often closed as early as noontime due to overcrowding.**

Buggies and push chairs are allowed into the Oktoberfest site, as long as it's not too full already: Until 6 pm you can feel free to use a buggy in the grounds. Exceptions are the Saturdays and the public holiday (on October 3rd): On these days buggies etc. may not be taken into the grounds at all. You can deposit your push chair at the entrances around the venue.

Please note: The maximum size of bags which can be brought into the Wiesn also applies to diaper bags, which may not be bigger than 10 cm x 20 cm x 15 cm (approx. 8 in x 6 in x 4 in)
